International Beatleweek 2021

Wow, what a year 2020 has been! Possibly even worse than 1970 when the Fab Four broke up! That same year, George introduced us to the concept that All Things Must Pass and that has to be our collective hope and belief as we look forward to August 2021 when for seven days and nights, the music of John, Paul, George and Ringo will ring out from every nook and cranny of the city. Over 70 of the finest tribute bands in the world together with fans from everywhere will be in Liverpool with one missionto come together to celebrate the music of the world's greatest band.

Last year's festival was cancelled, albeit we did manage to stage a 'virtual' celebration combined with a small gathering of fans and solo artists, as restrictions were temporarily suspended in Liverpool. However, with recent positive news regarding vaccines, it appears that we can 'get back' to some sort of normality and what better way than at Beatleweek 2021! This year we are combining many of last year's 50th anniversary themes of 1970 with those of 1971. Effectively celebrating two years in one.

Now in our 35th year of organising the Festival we will simultaneously commemorate the end of The Beatles era and celebrate the emergence of their phenomenal solo careers. The years 1970-71 saw the release of 'Let it Be' and a staggering nine solo albums (thirteen if you count 'All Things Must Pass' as three and 'Concert For Bangladesh' as a triple too) so lots to celebrate! If you haven't ever experienced the Festival you don't know what you are missing. It is by far the biggest and best in the world and you will make friends for life with like minded people the world over. Don't forget that apart from all of the shows and events chronicled in this brochure, there is live music on three stages at The Cavern Club and Pub everyday and if you book a package it includes free entry throughout your stay!

WEDNESDAY 25th AUGUST

Wednesday morning at five o'clock as the day begins... It's the start of Beatleweek 2021 at the world-famous Cavern Club 'Where it all Began'. Live Beatles music will be reverberating around Mathew

Street on the Cavern's three stages. With bands from over 20 countries and over 500 gigs in a week, it is the biggest celebration of its kind in the world. Come Together to join fellow fans to celebrate the world's biggest ever entertainment phenomenon, in Liverpool, 'Birthplace of The Beatles'.

28th AUGUST

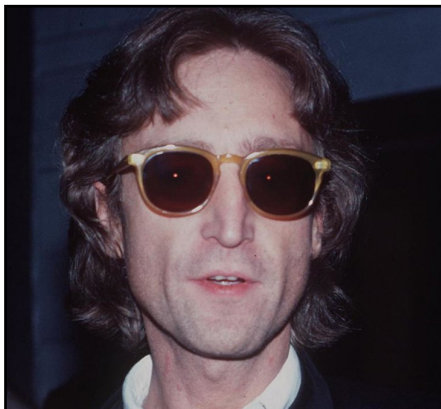
Saturday this year will be at two fantastic city centre venues. **Alma De Cuba** is a historic converted church and has long been one of our homes during Beatleweek.

Sunday can only mean one thing! Convention Day. The Beatles Convention started in Liverpool in the late seventies, but Liz and Jim Hughes brought it to The Adelphi in 1981 where it has been ever since. Everything

and anything Beatles is to be found here, make sure you bring some spending money for all of these amazing stalls! From breakfast time Sunday till breakfast time Monday, the live music is non-stop. The Convention finishes at midnight but after that is the annual 'Prellie All-Nighter' featuring another four stages into the wee small hours! The Beatles music is incessant. The market itself features dealers' rooms to find whatever collectible you are looking for, artwork, LPs, singles, box sets, autographs, special editions, photographs and much more. There are over 100 stalls and if it exists, the chances are you will find it there! We also have films, live stages, and very special VIP speakers which this year include **May Pang**, **Steve Holley** and **Laurence Juber (Wings)**, **Hunter Davies**, **Charles Rosenay** plus **Earl Slick**, **Andy Newmark**, **Tony Levin** (John Lennon's last band). It will be a 'long long long' day, but you will absolutely love it!

MONDAY
30th AUGUST

One of the highlights of 2019 was watching **Mark Lewisohn's Hornsey Road Show** in Liverpool. We always knew it would be good, as it is Mark, but it was absolutely amazing and we have managed to persuade him to re-stage it for the benefit of Beatleweek fans. An incredible journey examining the Recording of Abbey Road with insights and re-evaluations. Your afternoon will be complete

with live music in the bars of the Adelphi complex which will be a complementary contrast to Mark's excellent and original presentation.

The absolute highlight of the 2019 Festival was the amazing rooftop concert at The Shankly Hotel. The atmosphere was indescribable. The twilight panorama of the Liverpool skyline as a backdrop to incredible live music actually brought tears to the eyes. So in response to the demands of the fans, we will be returning

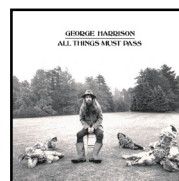
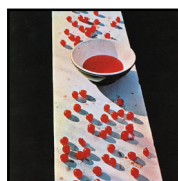

Wrapping things up, the last featured show in The Cavern is the **1970/71 Solo Years Concert**. What a start to a new decade for Beatles fans! 'Let It Be' plus the first solo albums, 'McCartney', 'All Things Must Pass', 'Sentimental Journey', 'Beaucoup of Blues' and 'Plastic Ono Band'. Let us not forget 'Instant Karma' and 'Live Peace in Toronto' charted for 32 consecutive weeks on Billboard as

well! Then we have the 1971 albums to celebrate such as 'Wild Life' and 'Ram', 'Concert for Bangladesh' and of course... 'Imagine'. Fifty years on and for those of us who bought all of the above on the day they came out... where have all the years gone? But it wasn't the end... it was a new beginning and one we are still enjoying as Paul and Ringo continue to write and record new material over fifty years later. The Cavern will be rocking in The Live Lounge during two shows commemorating those amazing two years whilst the Front Stage and The Cavern Pub will feature over thirty other bands during the day and night.
